when you take away their breath,  
they die and return again to the dust.  
32 When you send forth your spirit, they

may the Lord rejoice in his works;  
34 He looks on the earth and it  
trembles;  
he touches the mountains and they  
smoke.  
35 I will sing to the Lord as long as I live;  
I will make music to my God while I have  
my being.  
36 So shall my song please him  
while I rejoice in the Lord.  
37b Bless the Lord, O my soul. Alleluia.
